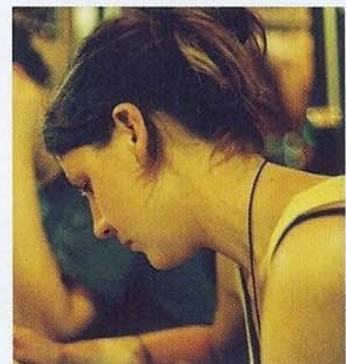
#### Jennifer Bolt

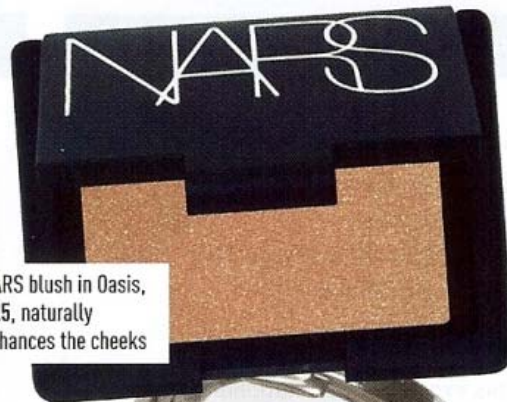
## Natural glow

Big day make-up can be subtle and pretty. There is nothing more beautiful on a wedding day than a bride whose skin looks as if it is glowing from within. Use an illuminating tinted moisturiser all over the face and use natural, soft tones on the eyes, cheeks and lips. If you're not used to wearing make-up, this is the look for you — and it can be worn with any wedding dress style.

NARS blush in Oasis, £25, naturally enhances the cheeks

If your wedding dress is fitted or has a glamorous fishtail shape, this smoky sophisticated look is for you. Flawless skin and bronzer make the skin look radiant. For the eyes, apply a highlighter to the brow bone, the middle shade to the eyelid and the darker shade in the contour and the lash line. Line the lashes with a black eyeshadow pencil and smudge the line with a brush to achieve Diane's look.

This fine brush will coat every lash. Daniel Sandler Baby Jet Mascara, £12.50

All the eyeshadow colours you need in one compact: Bourjois Trio Lumière Eyeshadow Trio in Brun Cuives, £6.50

Apply YSL Longlasting Eyeshadow Pencil in black, £14.50, along the top and bottom lash line and smudge

Apply on cheeks, forehead and chin for a sunny glow. Sun Shimmer Maxi Bronzer by Rimmel London, £4.99

Take that classic 1940s Hollywood siren face and update it with lips that are slightly matted down. Use minimal blusher and a flick of liner on the eyes. Line the upper lash line with this long-lasting liquid eyeliner. Shu Uemura Liquid Eyeliner, £19

Apply Laura Mercier Secret Camouflage Concealer, £25, under eyes and on any blemishes



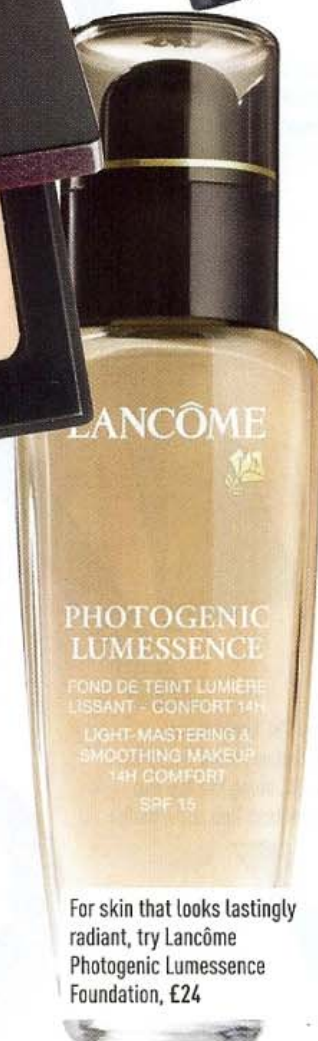
Apply Daniel Sandler High Impact Lipstick in Torch, £12, with your finger for a modern look

# Pretty in pink

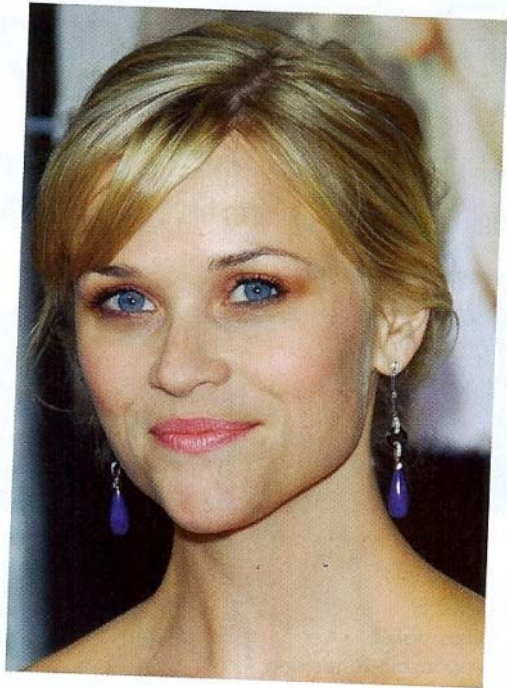
Apply this under your foundation to illuminate your skin. Dermalogica Day Bright, £32.40
