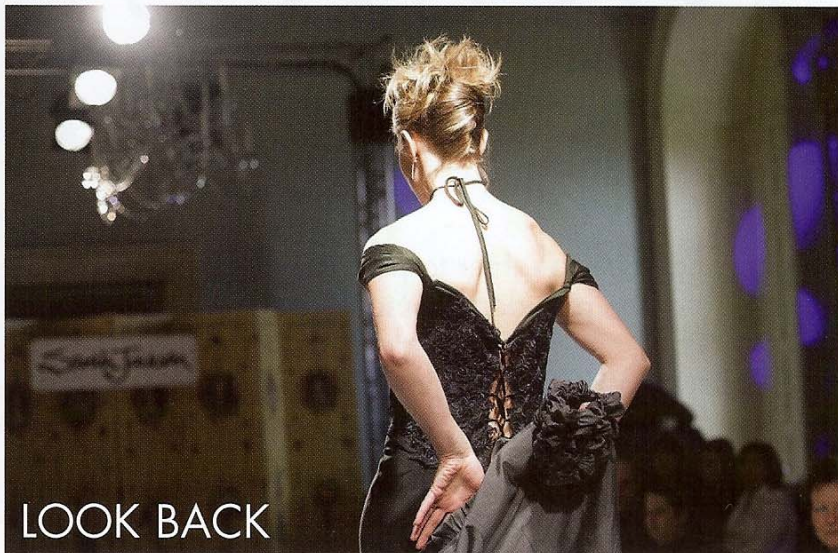

## LOOK BACK

**Q** I have long hair and I am really worried about which style to choose for my wedding. Any suggestions?

**A Luci Foreman says:** The possibilities are endless! You could choose an up-do, but remember the back is as important as the front. Crimped styles are cutting edge cool at the moment, while a glossy bun is eternally chic and soft chignons created from loose pin-curls are timeless and romantic.

## Hot and Bothered

**Q** I am getting married abroad later this year and the weather will be hot. I want to wear foundation - what would you suggest?

**A Sarah Brock says:** It is essential that you use a silicone-based primer under your foundation. The Daniel Sandler Retexturising Primer (£13.50) will help your foundation last longer and will diminish fine lines. Choose a foundation which is not heavy or greasy as it will slide off. Look for oil-free, silicone-based foundations. The Daniel Sandler Mineral Tint (£20) looks beautiful and also has SPF20 protection to help guard your skin from the sun.

**Q** I'd like to wear a veil and hair accessories with a trendy edge at my forthcoming church wedding, what do you recommend?

**A Luci Foreman says:** Complete your big day hair look with that all-important bridal hair accessory, a classic tiara. Finally, choose a shorter-length veil as they are set to be big news for Spring/Summer 2008.

## My Best Friend's Wedding

**Q** I have three bridesmaids, who will be applying their own make-up on the day. I want them to look beautiful in the photographs - do you have any tips?

**A Sarah Brock says:** First, as with the bride, advise them not to choose anything too bold or bright. Staying with a more natural look is the best way to assure beautiful pictures. They should choose a natural eyeshadow that will compliment any skin tone, (I love the Daniel Sandler Sheer Satin Eyeshadow in Gilded Taupe, £9). A pretty pink or coral blush is perfect and a good lipstick colour is the Daniel Sandler Luxury Lipstick in Pucker, £12.50. Remember, you never want the bridesmaids' look to overshadow the bride!
